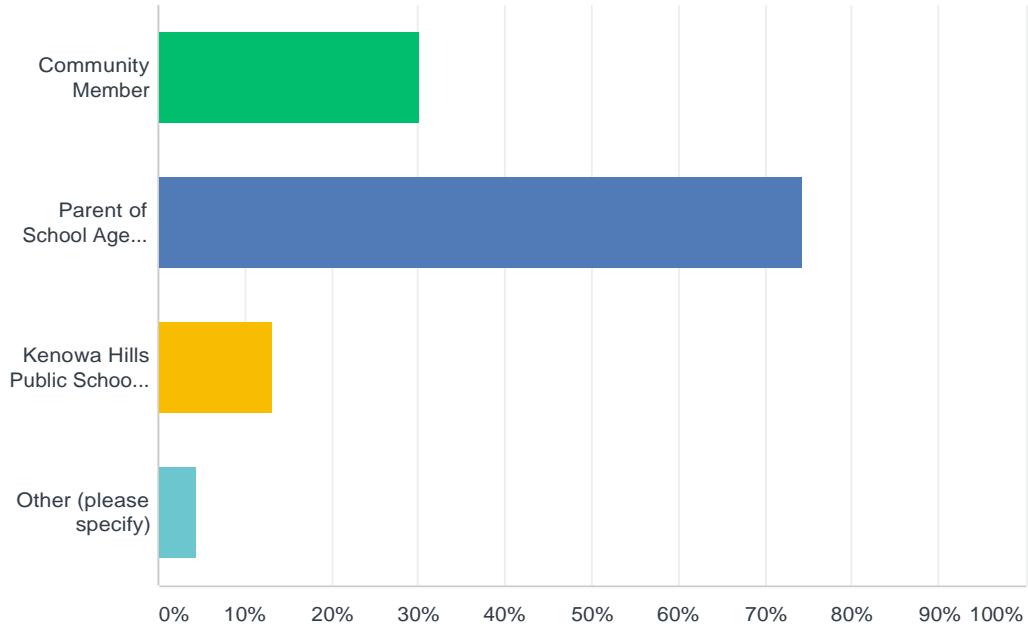

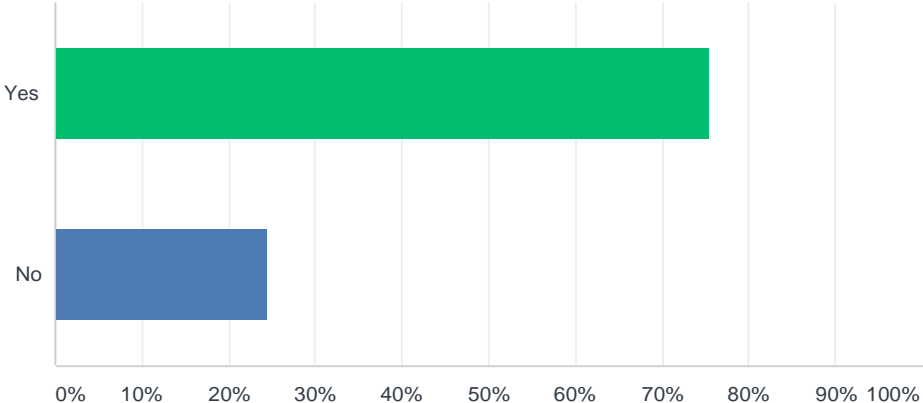

Q2 Do you currently have children attending Kenowa Hills Public Schools?

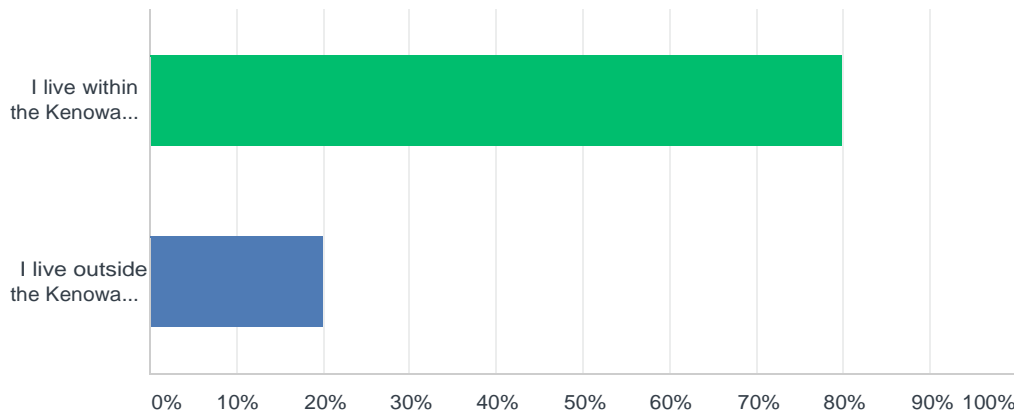

Q3 Do you live within the Kenowa Hills district boundaries or does your child attend through School of Choice?

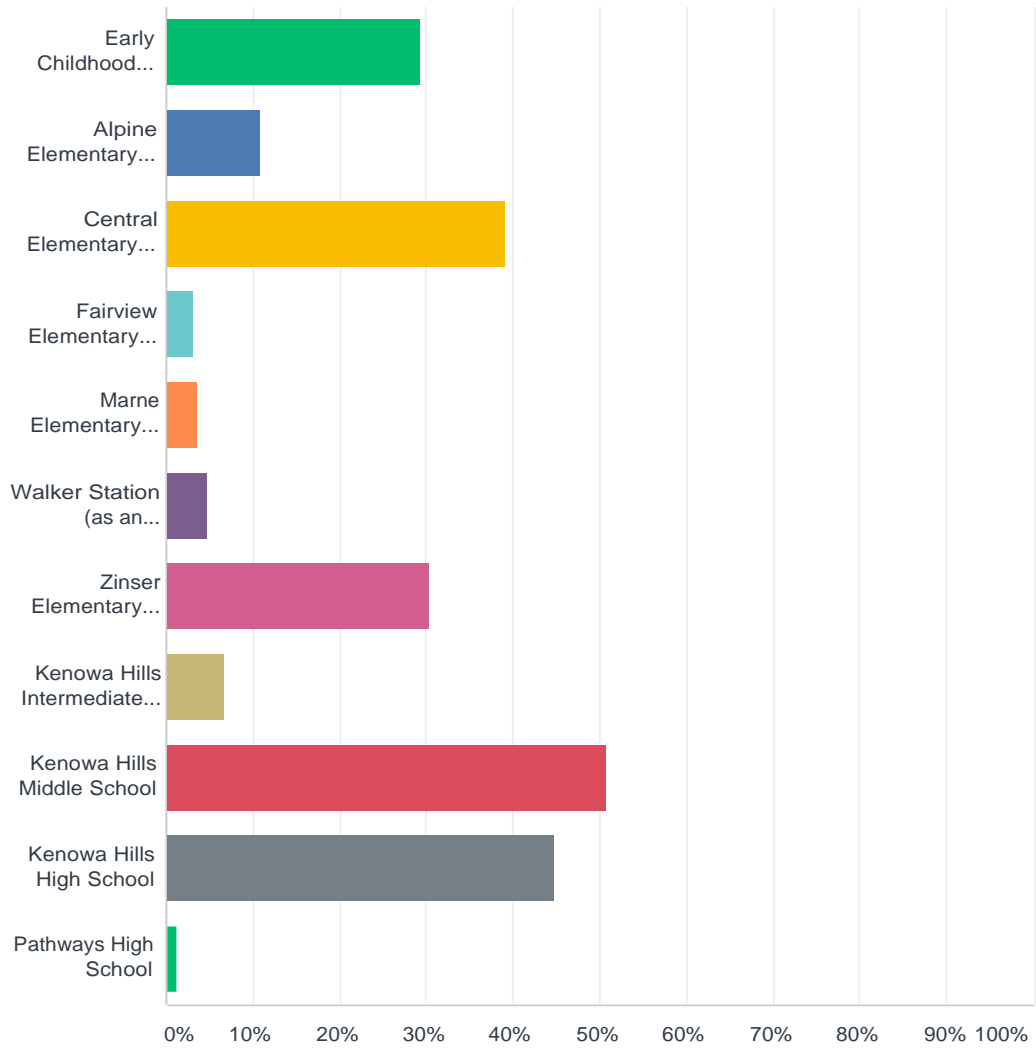

Q4 Please select the building(s) your child(ren) currently attend or did attend (check all that apply).

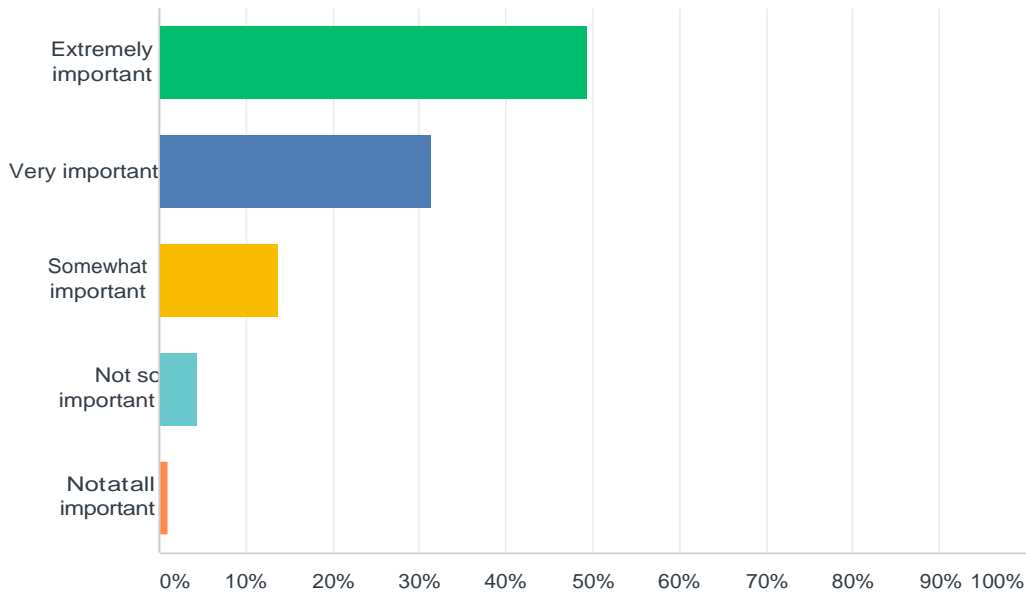

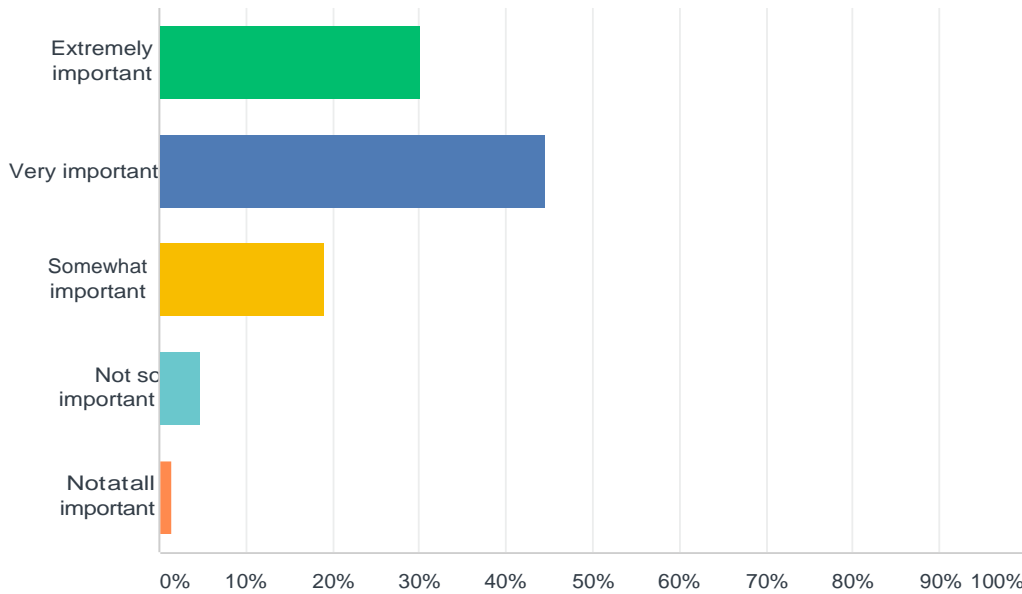

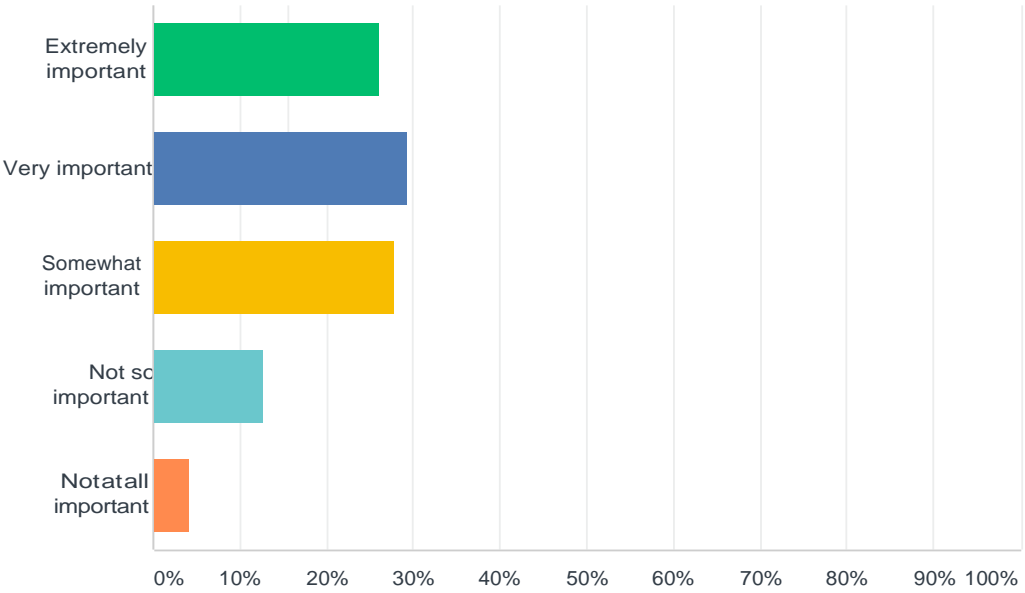

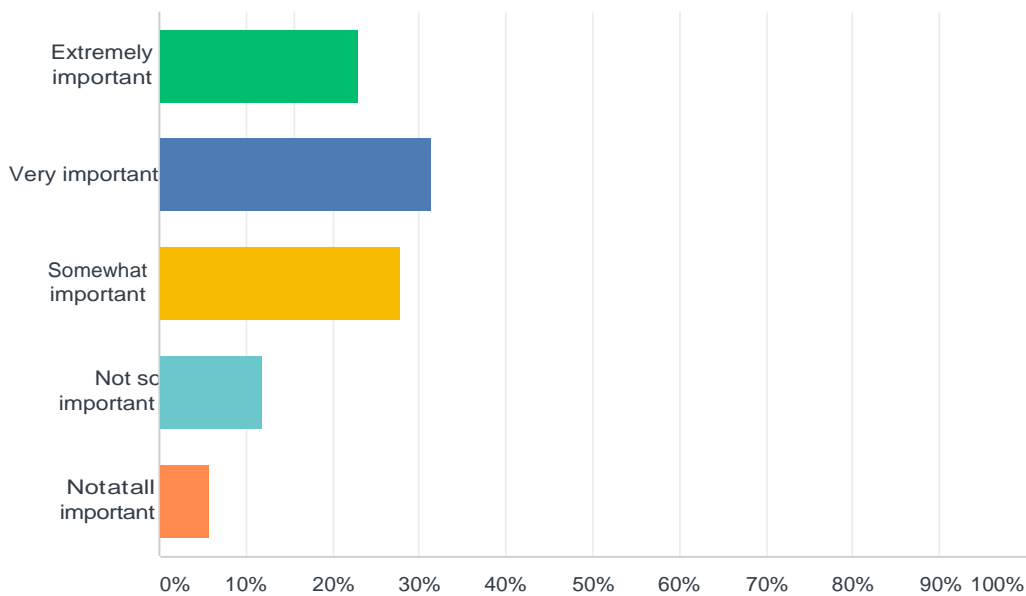

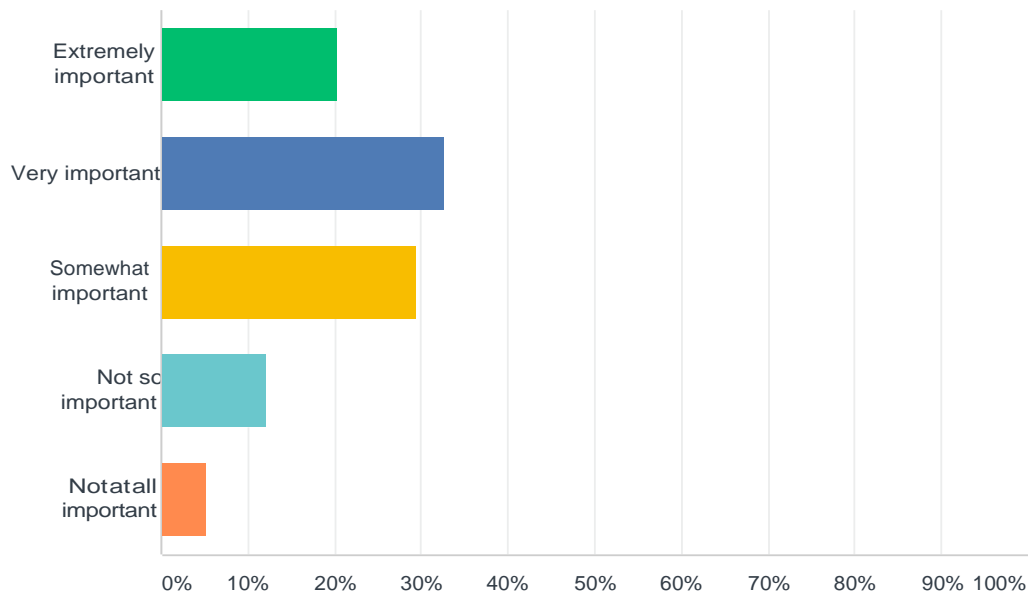

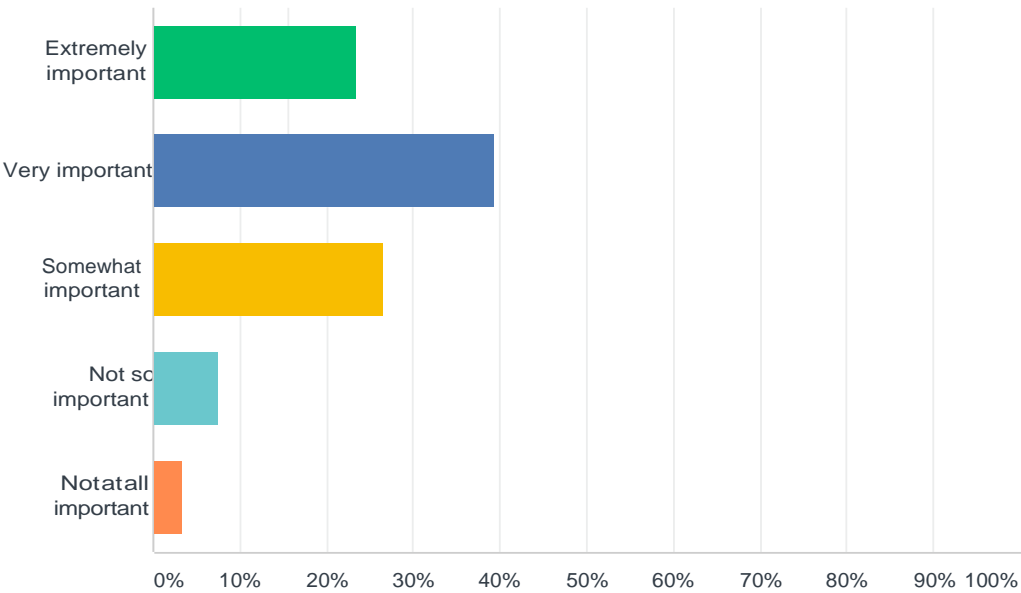

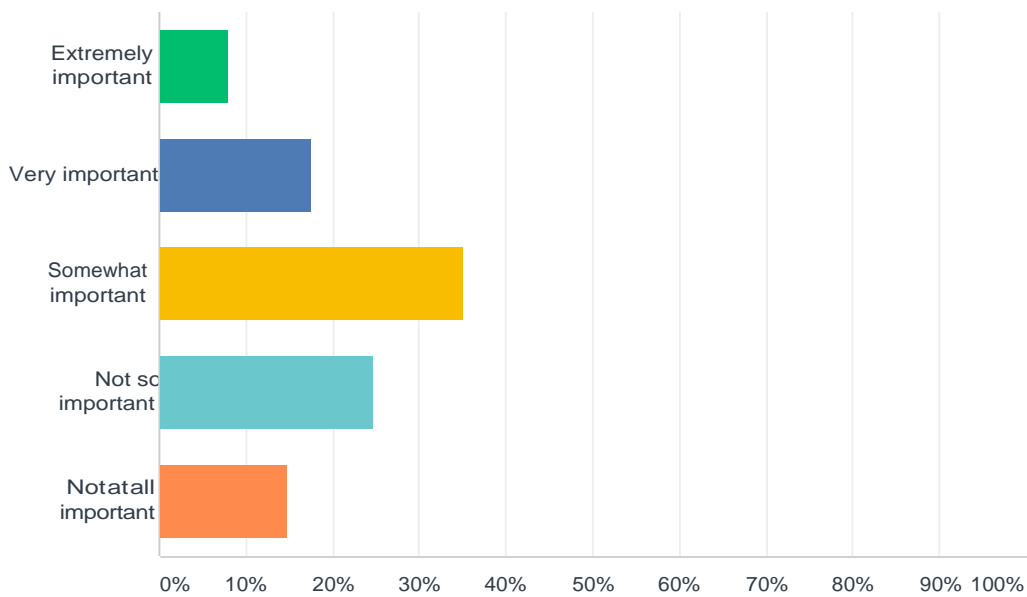

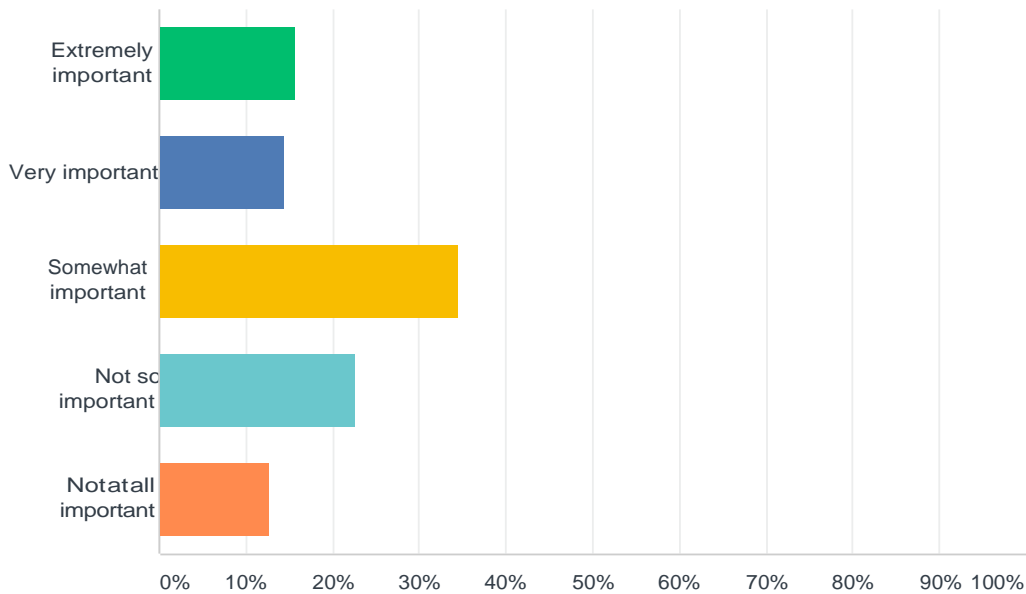

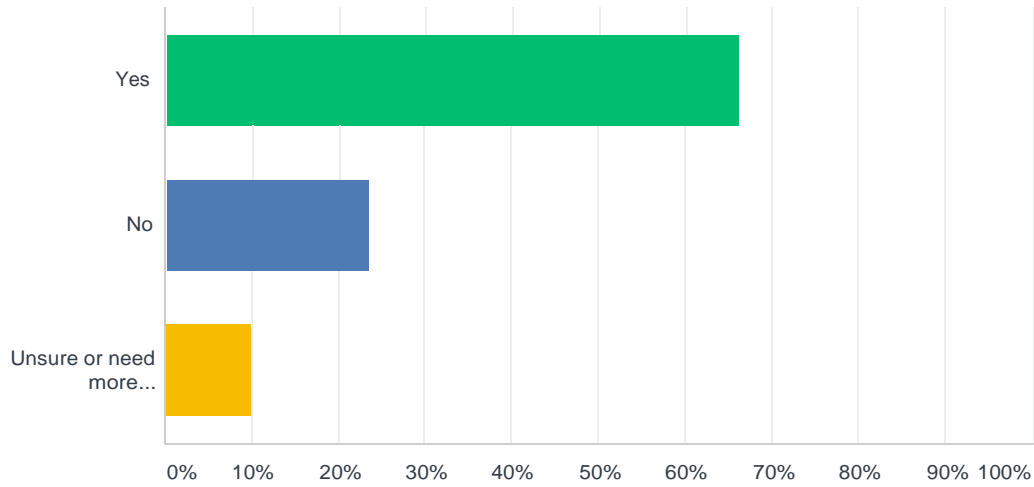

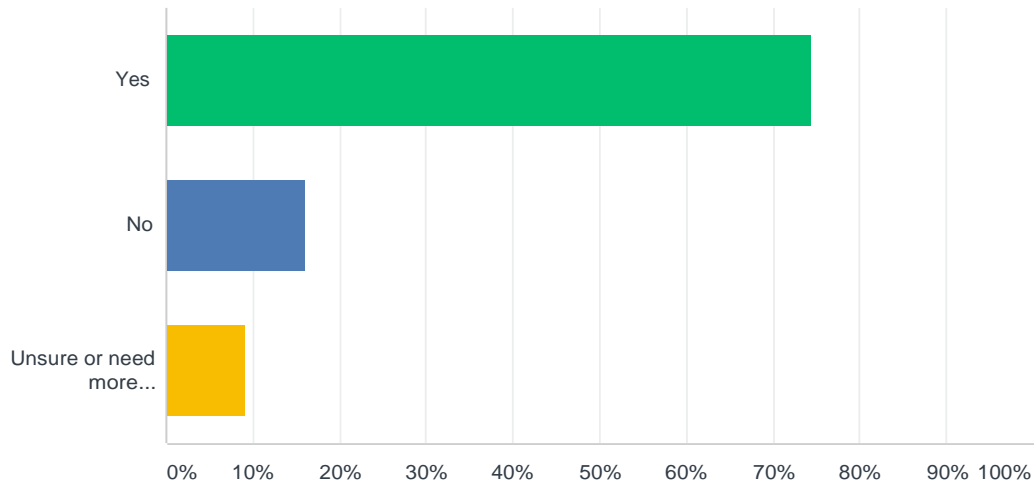

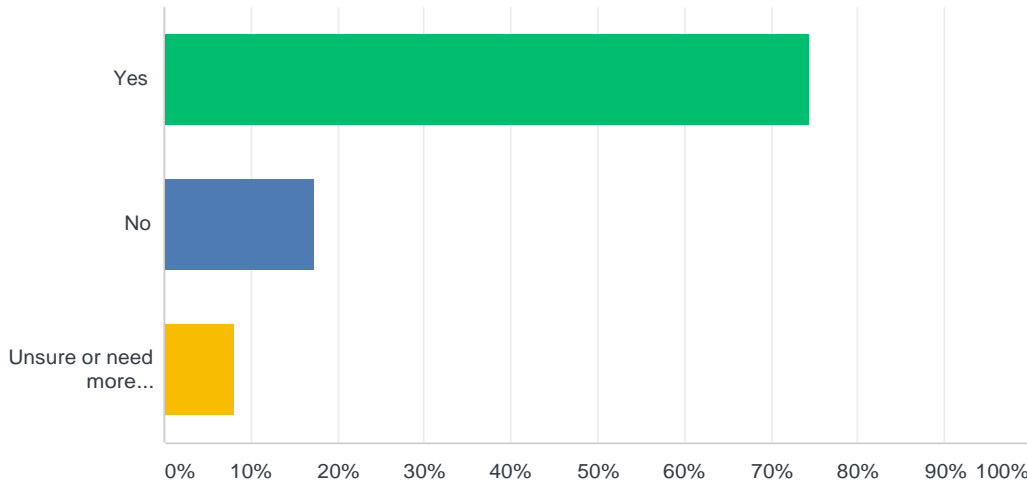

Q15 Based on the information provided in this survey, would you generally support a bond proposal that did not increase the millage rate in order to meet the building and site needs of our district?

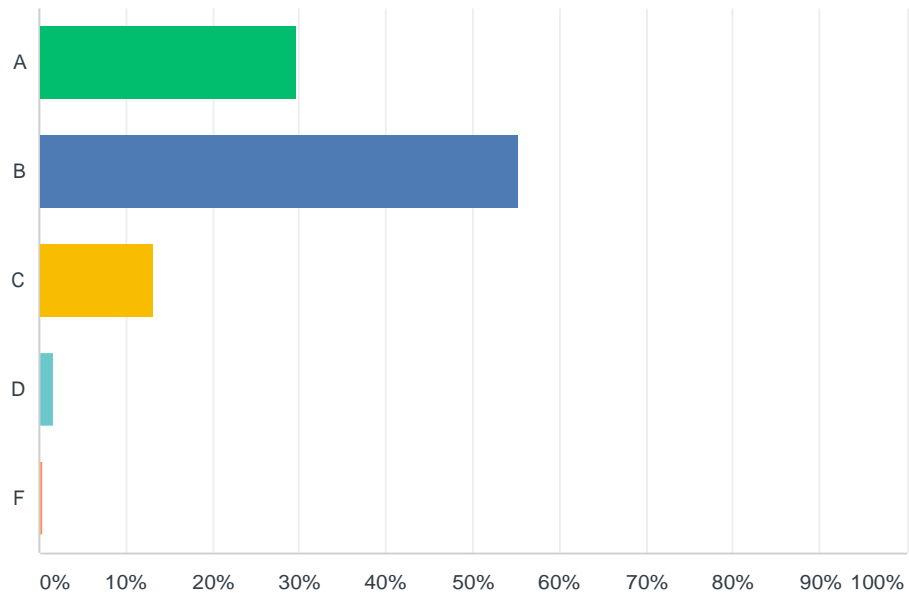

Q16 Grade the quality of education Kenowa Hills Public Schools provides to its students.

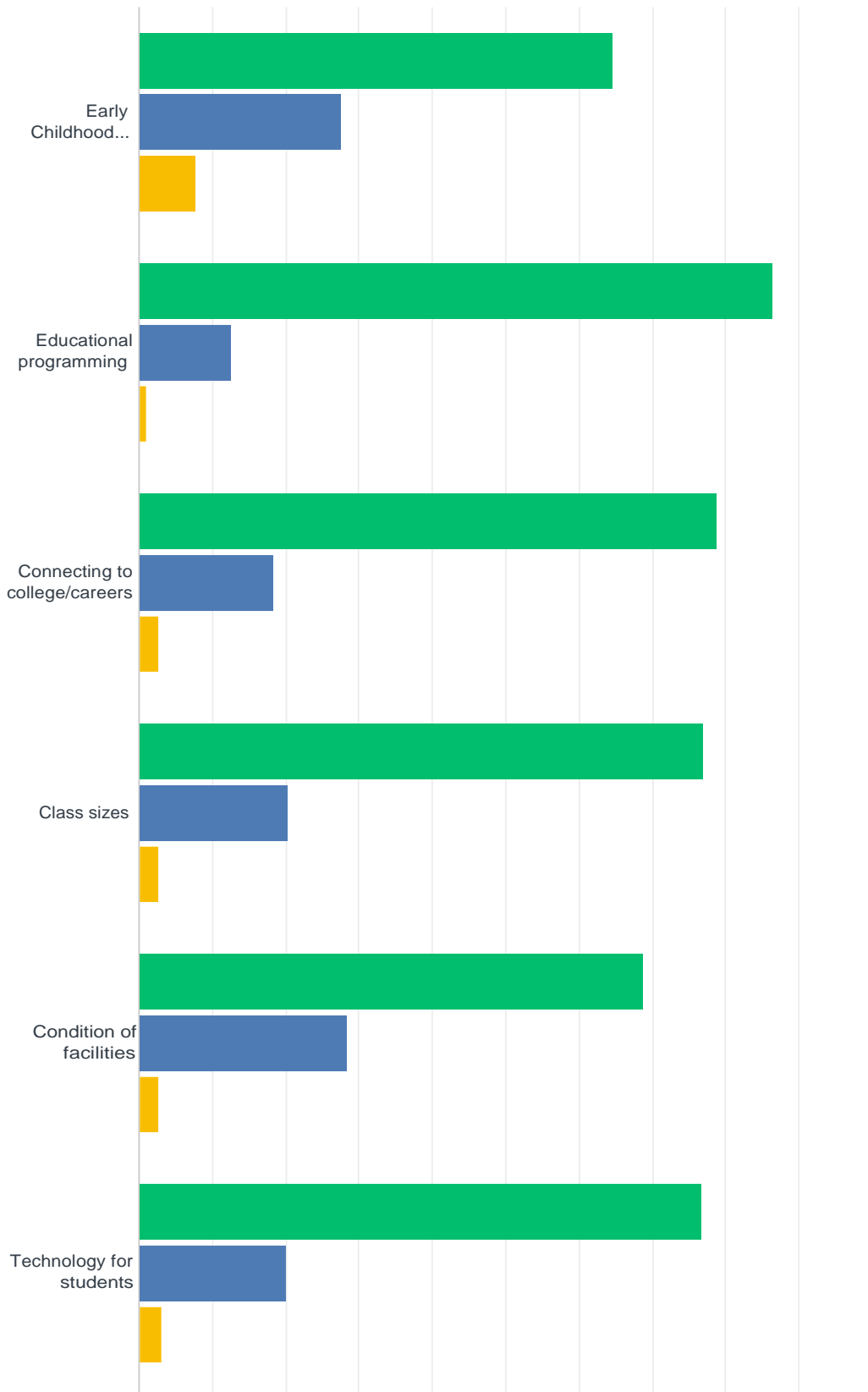

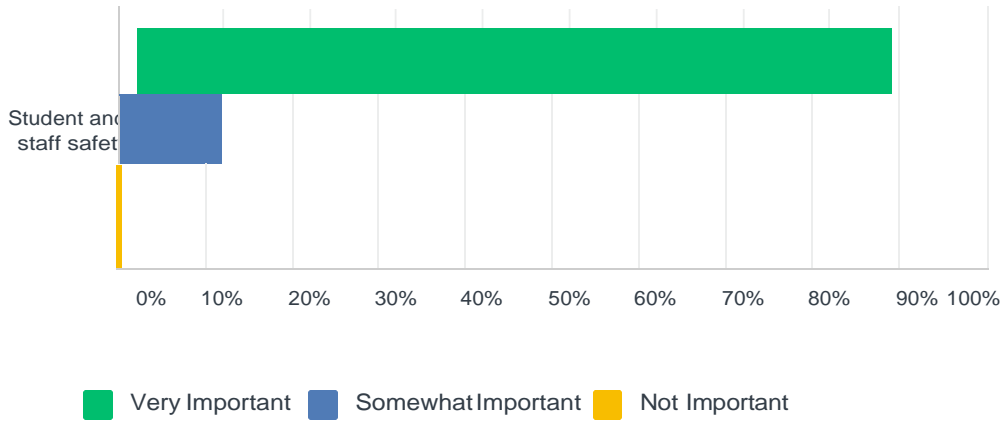
